

Team G Gateus Raptoralium returned to the Pole along Conzelman Road on the Marin Headland on 4/23 for our Raptorthon count day. The day started with fog, clouds and wind, and then became sunny in the afternoon. We started at 9:30 a.m. and ended our count at 4:00 p.m.

We had a great day and observed 7 raptor species: 43 Turkey Vultures, 26 Red-tailed



Hawks, 4 Cooper's Hawks, 5 Sharp-shinned Hawks, 1 White-tailed Kite, 2 Osprey, and 2 Peregrine Falcons (literally our last species of the day!). Other highlights of non-raptors included 3 Caspian Terns flying overhead, and a gazillion of Brant's Cormorants flying over the water throughout the day. Check out our eBird checklist and photos.
